

Fees

A fee of \$5.00 is charged for all electronic equipment. This fee is used to cover the costs associated with transportation, processing and disposal of the equipment.

Equipment items that are accepted at CBC Recycling include:

Television Sets (No Consoles), Computer Monitors, Laptops and Notebooks, Computer Processing Units (CPU)*, Printers, Fax Machines, Copiers, Stereo Equipment, Video Cameras, Video Game Consoles, DVD Players, Video Cassette Recorders (VCR).

*You are responsible for removing data from your hard drive.

What happens to the electronic waste?

Electronic equipment is collected.



If the units are not able to be refurbished, all parts will be recycled. This will keep hazardous materials out of our landfills.



Items are sorted into groups:

Equipment that is able to be refurbished, and



Equipment that is beyond repair.



Items that are able to be restored are donated to local non-profit organizations.



Why recycle electronic waste?

- According to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) approximately 250 million computers will become obsolete within the next five years.
- Some electronics contain hazardous materials that can threaten our lives if not properly disposed of.
- There is approximately four pounds of lead in each computer monitor and television.
- Since 2004, approximately 50,000 pounds of electronic waste has been diverted from Genesee County landfills.
